

## Xbox only rules:

Due to the number of signups for the Xbox tournament we have had to be creative with the tournament progression, introducing a "Lucky Loser" and "League Finals", in order to find out: Who is the best FIFA player at Essex?

## LUCKY LOSER

Round One and Two will work as normal, where the winner of the fixture is through to the next round and the loser will have to watch the rest of the tournament from the bench. However, in Round Three we will have 5 teams remaining, leaving us with an uneven number of teams, this is where we introduce the Lucky Loser. The introduction of a LL will see the re-entrance of the player who was knocked out in Round Two but had the best goal difference of those teams that were knocked out. This player will re-enter the tournament in Round Three allowing the tournament to continue with 6 teams remaining.

## LEAGUE FINALS

After Round Three we will have 3 teams remaining. These 3 teams will enter a league system where all 3 teams play each other once. The 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be knocked out of the tournament and the top two will progress to the big livestreamed final. The league will be scored as follows: 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. Goal Difference will separate any teams on the same score.
