



GOLD STANDARD REQUIREMENTS CHEAT SHEET

SECTION 1 – Volunteering Events

- Conduct 5 Volunteering Events with at least 3 attendees each, and logged volunteering hours on [Gradintel](#).

SECTION 2 – Executive Committee Volunteering Log

- 75% of execs have created a volunteering profile and logged minimum 15 hours of any work done as executive committee members on [Gradintel](#).

SECTION 3 – Funds Raised

- Raised at least £800 for own society or external charity (only 50% can come from society memberships).

SECTION 4 - Executive Committee Meetings

- Conducted 12 executive committee meetings with at least 3 executive committee members in attendance with proof of dates.

SECTION 5 – Admin

- At least two exec members attending General Meetings.
- Attendance at mandatory training (or have read the training slides if unable to attend).
- Promoted General Elections to members.
- Submitted a society constitution/start-up form.
- Compliance with [Societies Terms of Reference](#).
- Events posted on SU What's On and society webpage up to date.
- Budget not exceeded.
- Society found not guilty of disciplinary offences (not including individual offences).

SECTION 6 - Social Events

- Conducted 10 social events.

SECTION 7 – Society Engagement

- Host at least 1 social/activity per month
- Host a welcome event for society members
- Actively engage or collaborate with an SU-ran event, campaign or community group.
- Collaborate once another society or sports club.
- Have an active social media account (post at least once a week during term time).
- Ran a stall at Fresher's Fair and/or Opportunities Fair

***All sections require proof to be processed for Gold Standard. To achieve Gold in any section, you must also meet the Bronze and Silver requirements.**
